There are so many local, community, or regional activities that you can join. We searched around and uncovered some helpful hints to get you started.

The largest one is Kansas City Barbecue Society (KCBS), but some other networks are ICBA, FBA and MBN. These groups will let you search for local contests, giving you the dates and costs.

Here are some helpful hints:

- Does the competition have novice and professional categories?
- Enter an easy category
- Check the dates and costs
- Submit an application
- Attend some BBQ competitions to see what to expect
- Talk to some of the professionals
- Know the rules of the contest
- Invite a friend or spouse to join you
- Scan the Internet for ideas
- Prepare for your event – make a timeline
- If allowed, trim your meats at home
- Make a supply list
- Practice your recipe
- Don't make last minute changes
- Above all, have fun with your new BBQ adventure
