

Halloween Ghost Board

Bring a little BOO-tiful fun to your Halloween gathering with this playful Ghost Board made entirely from white, black, and orange treats. It's easy to assemble and even more fun to serve. No tricks, just treats!

SERVES

10 to 12

BOARD

24 × 18-inch (61 × 46 cm) black board

UTENSILS

3 letter-shaped cookie cutters that spell "BOO" (3 inches, or 7.5 cm, tall x 2½ inches, or 6 cm, wide), scoop, and mini tongs

Ingredients

35 white chocolate— or yogurt-covered pretzels

1 cup (160 g) Halloween Blend (orange and black) Milk Chocolate M&M's, plus more for serving

10 cups (150 g) salted popcorn

11 ghost-shaped or plain potato chips

1 bag (7½ ounces, or 212 g) Halloween gummies mix (such as Albanese

Ghoulish Gummies), divided (use the white ghost shapes; reserve the other shapes for serving bowls)

7 Reese's White Creme Peanut Butter Ghosts

19 Halloween Oreo cookies, divided

5 Peeps Marshmallow Ghosts

1 Create an outline of the ghost by arranging the white pretzels in a large ghost shape on the board, leaving more space at the top of the ghost for the witch's hat.

2 Place the "B-O-O" cookie cutters on the bottom center of the ghost shape and fill each one with the Halloween M&M's.

3 Spoon the popcorn around the cookie cutters and inside the ghost shape, then evenly spread it to fill the shape completely.

4 Tuck in the potato chips, ghost gummies, and Reese's Ghosts throughout the popcorn.

5 Use 3 of the Oreos for the ghost's eyes and mouth. Stack the remaining 16 Oreos in a triangle shape above the right side of the ghost's head to form a witch hat, exposing the orange-filling on 6 of the Oreos for color contrast.

6 Scatter 3 of the Peeps Ghosts around the ghost shape on the board and the other 2 at the side of the board.

Serving Notes

Enjoy this board within 2 hours of assembling, before snacks lose their crunch. Keep it out of direct sunlight or heat to prevent candies and chocolate from melting.
